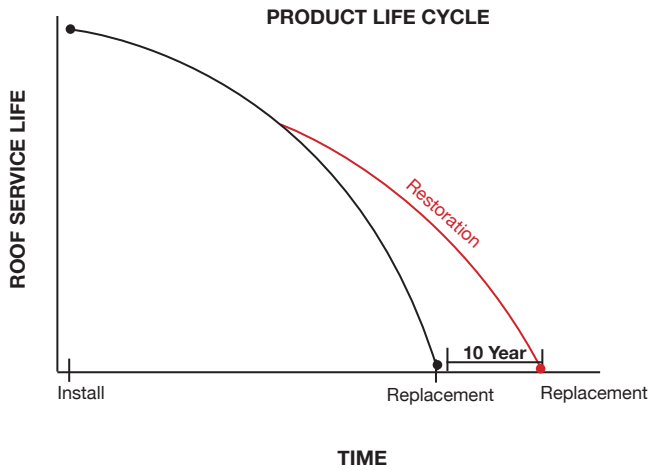


WeatherScreen
